NOAA is at the forefront of many of this Nations most critical issues from weath-er forecasting to fisheries management, from safe navigation to coastal services and from environmental observations through NOAAs satellites to climate research and ocean exploration. The Administration requests 3. 326 billion for these people, products and services for Fiscal Year 2004. This represents a very modest total increase of 45. 0 million, only about 1. 4 more than the fiscal year 03 enacted amount. It targets essentials, such as 284. 2 million in program changes of which 52. 0 million are adjustments to base (ATBs), or mandatory cost increases, which are mostly inflationary costs re-lated to salaries for NOAA employees.
