Sable, a chevron engrailed between three crosses patee fitchee argent - as many fleur de lis gules. Crest a heron s head erased sable guttee d or, in the beak gules a fish argent. 1. Henry Smith and his wife Judith, three sons and two daughters, three man servants and two maid servants came from Ha - en Hall in Norfolk, England, in 1638, and settled in New Hingham. He was freeman in 1639; was one of the first two deacons of the church here, representative in 1641. He removed with his family about 1643 to Rehoboth, Mass., where he died in 1649. In his will dated Nov. 3rd, 1647, he names brother Thomas Cooper, sons Henry and Daniel and daughter Judith, all the persons above named came over in the year 1638 and were in the Ship Diligent of Ipswich.
