A very remarkable little plant of doubtful immediate affinity, occurring, according to Mr. W. S. Hamilton (l. c), with Tilla, for which it is, at first sight, most readily mistaken, and other aquatic or semi-aquatic growths, with which it carpets the river-bottom to a very considerable depth. The leaves are strictly opposite, the petioles being, indeed, connate, and the seeds contain a copious albumen, which is wanting in Boragcm pruper. I have been unable to satisfy myself entirely as to the stivation, farther than that it appears to be imbricate, though in what sequence...
