John R. Mohler and Adoph Eichhorn, of the Pathological Division of this bureau. Since the discovery of the glanders bacillus in 1883 many efforts have been made to find a reliable method of making an early diagnosis of the disease. The mallein test and later the agglutination test have been and are at present in general use, but neither of these is sufficiently reliable to be entirely satisfactory. Sechutz and Schubert, German investigators, recently called attention to the value of complement fixation as affording a more reliable method of diagnosing glanders, and within the past year this method has been carefully studied and tested in the Pathological Division of this bureau. It will be seen from the details given in the accompanying paper that the authors have found the complement fixation test to be highly reliable as a diagnostic agent for glanders, and they present a thorough exposition...
